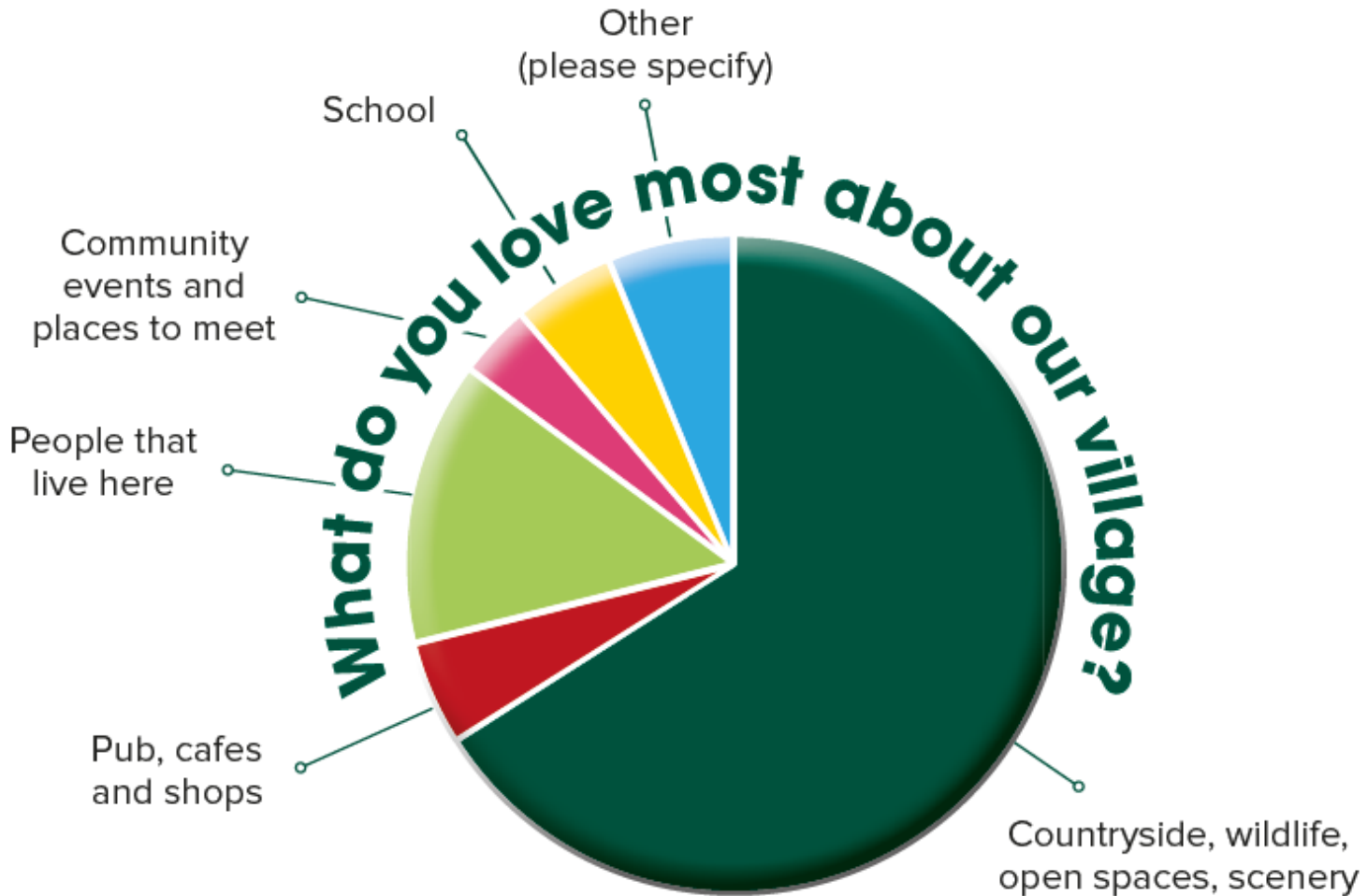

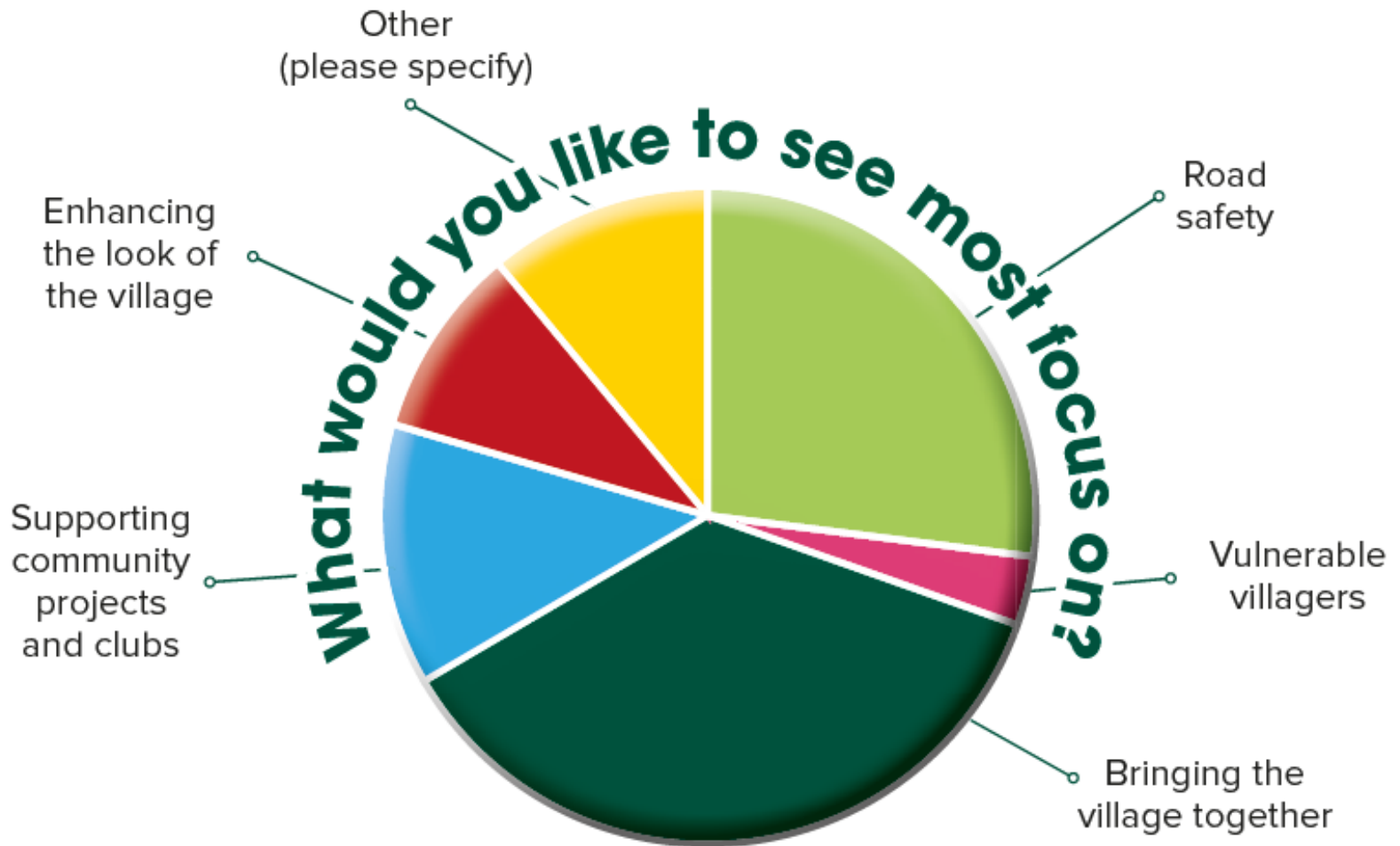
To champion the interests of the village of Langton Green and its residents

Constitution issued with papers ahead of AGM – Summary of Material Changes

- Remove reference to 'men' – any reference to Chairman / Vice Chairman etc is now 'Chair' / 'Vice Chair'
- Added reference to Social Media as a means to communicate with the LGVS
- Removed the mandatory annual subscription and re-worded as voluntary, giving the LGVS flexibility to re-structure the membership (particularly important in post COVID economy)
- Added ability to flex up or down committee membership around the cap of 15
- Provided more flexibility around the operation of the LGVS meetings, including agenda, distribution of papers – e.g. agenda issued 48 hours not 1 week ahead, AGM in first half of year vs March
- Reduced the limit from £1000 to £500 for second signature on expenses
- Re-stated mission statement
