- **3. Langton Pavilion Café** EH provided a brief update on the re-opening of the café noting she was still not able to start trading. An EGM is to be held by SPC at the Pavilion Café on Thursday 15 June at 7:30pm where the only matter up for discussion is the future of the café.
- **4. Langton Green Festival –** Organisation is well underway with this event held in lieu of the fete / party on the green and in collaboration with Tunbridge Wells Fringe Festival. We still need a team of volunteers to help with setting up the field at Hollonds Farm on Friday 7 July and clearing up on Sunday 9 July. We need to ensure we have sufficient card readers and that they all work on the field. We discussed setting prices for drinks etc...
- **5. Finances** DW updated that bank balance continues around the £30,000 with increase in spending associated with the Festival.
- **6. Road Safety -** DW updated on the progress of the plan to establish a crossing at the point where the twitten ends and pedestrians cross over to the recreation ground. SPC and LGVS are working with KCC on the issue.
