- 1. Minutes of previous meeting were agreed prior to the meeting via email.
- **2. Drinking water fountain** JB has been to Chilstone to look at possibilities and has identified it should cost around £500. SPC has asked for a written proposal regarding putting it on The Rec. There is also the possibility of putting it close to the church on The Green. JB and MG will be putting together the proposal.
- **3. Langton Green Fete 2024 –** MG will lead the Fete Committee in deciding the venue for next year's fete. It is thought the Tunbridge Wells Fringe Festival will provide some of the entertainment on the day.
- **4. Finances** DW updated that after donating £2000 to the church as previously agreed, there is £29000 in the bank account. We will be spending around £400 for planters along the Langton Road in conjunction with Langton Life.
- **5. Road Safety –** DW noted there has been no progress on the safe crossing and speed restrictions he is pursuing with SPC / KCC.
- **6. Gatwick –** JS agreed to provide information at the AGM.
